ACTIVITY SIGN: Please provide a sign at the front of your activity or event informing everybody: what unit you are, where you meet and a contact person if desired.

SET UP / TAKE DOWN: Setup for all activities will take place from 8:00 AM until 9:40 AM on Saturday morning. Booth removal will be from 4:00 PM until 5:00 PM. Please do not leave early. Those with large items to drop off will want to note this on their application. Only a few vehicles will be allowed into the park at a time to unload.

OPENING CEREMONY: The opening ceremony will take place on Saturday at 10:00 AM. All Scouts and Scouters should meet at the assembly area at this time.

LUNCH: Vendors will be open to purchase food throughout the day. You may also bring your own food and drinks.
